

## 170 New Jobs Coming to Seneca Army Depot

Romulus, New York (WSYR-TV) – Two companies announced Monday they would be expanding their operations at the Seneca Army Depot, adding approximately 170 jobs. Top Quality Hay Processors and Seneca Bioenergy are using an \$850 thousand state grant to help support the expansion.

Top Quality Hay Processors is a company that takes hay cut from the field and dries and bakes the hay indoors in a matter of hours instead of several days, reducing limitations imposed by the weather. The company is expected to create 90 new jobs at the depot by later this year.

Seneca Bioenergy is in the middle of constructing an agricultural manufacturing facility with the ability to crush soybeans and canola to produce renewable energy and biodiesel fuels. Construction should be complete by the end of 2008.

The company hired approximately 65 construction workers and once the new facility is open, an extra 80 permanent manufacturing jobs will be created.
